

Israela Hargil shows on an exhibition in Hen Boulevard several sculptures. One 2x2x2 meters weighting 5 tons was transferred from Ramat-Gan there it will be placed regularly in a park, after a competition in which Israela won a price.

The inspiration for these sculptures and their horizontal lines are the rocks in the Negev and Sinai deserts, she says. The unusual material - large blocks of ytong - cast in maximum density, serves almost as Alabaster for the artist to work with. Israela's large sculpture is an example for the importance of an exhibition in a public place like Hen Boulevard where an usual art can be seen by wide audiences.
