The sculptor Israela Hargil is remembered from her exhibition at Ganei Yehoshua where she presented marble sculptures and Itung models. A continuation of these models has now been found: in an office building recently built in Neot Afeka, the artist erected a large-scale sculpture made entirely of Itung. The sculpture is a focal point for the eye in a patio with glass walls.

The sculpture is 3 m wide and 3.5 m high. Its shapes are abstract, but it evokes the association of a large, stylish flower and is also reminiscent of elements of construction.

Israela Hargil once again did well to emphasize the texture of the unique material.
